CORRESPONDENCE

- a. Received Seneca Resources gas well activities for the area.

ROADMASTER REPORT

Mason Hill Road project is coming along fine and to an end. The projected cost is going to be somewhere between \$35,000.00 and \$40,000.00. A lot of stone was used especially around the Fred's Wood area.

OLD BUSINESS

- a. The townships 2 way radios – They were delayed again. Due to a fire in the plant they are having a tough time getting the microprocessors. The estimated date is now October 20th.
- b. Scott Strayer attended the Hazmat meeting in Emporium. It was about anything that could be a disaster in the area. Tornados, floods, hurricanes, etc. A meeting has to be attended yearly.

- c. The county adopted LERTA. (Local Economic Revitalization Tax Assistance). There doesn't seem to be any new business's coming to Gibson Township currently, but it doesn't hurt to pass it for the future.
- d. Fall clean up went well. 2 dumpsters were brought in.

NEW BUSINESS:

- a. The township will be advertising shortly for the Road Crew.
- b. The township had a camp owner (at no charge) offered to plant bushes, flowers and mulch it so it doesn't have to be mowed. The only thing he asked for were 5-6 volunteers to help on a Saturday. He wants to do it this fall. Ernie will volunteer his time. We need more volunteers.
- c. The township still has not received its 2020 Audit back yet. A message has been left for the auditors.

PUBLIC COMMENT:

- a. Why did the township get charged \$12.50 for stop payment on check for the Cemetery donation? Previous Treasurer sat on the check to long and the donor stopped payment on it.
- b. What's going on with the Jerry Run bank account? The money will sit in the account until the project is done. Then the Conservation District will ask for the funds for Gibson Township portion.
- c. Did the township find another Solicitor yet? This is currently being worked on.
- d. Has anyone been bonded yet? Yes, Scott Yandric has been bonded since the last Treasurer left. Don't believe the rumors about someone not being bonded and checks being signed by people that are not on the checking account.

Scott Yandric wanted to remind the public that there is a number for the township shed. If there are any road issues or trash issues call 814-546-2019 and talk to the Roadmaster. The Driftwood Saloon is not part of the township and neither is Scott Yandric's personal cell phone.
