ROADMASTER REPORT

Roller needs tires (minor). Roller has been rented out to Grove and Benezette Townships.

Jerry Run project is almost finished. Nanny Run will be scheduled next.

Locked when worker's leave at 3p, if anyone leaves trash after hours we can take to the State Police for littering.

IRS Increases Mileage Allowance for Second Half of 2022 - Due to record gas prices, the IRS mileage rate for business use of a personal vehicle will increase from 58.5 cents per mile to 62.5 cents per mile. The new mileage rate eligibility is effective July 1 - December 31, 2022. The board of supervisors may choose to adjust its mileage rate up to the revised IRS rate for the second half of the year.
