- Truck repairs
- Trash signage being ordered this week
 - Unknown truck left mattresses at trash site, valve stems cut on some of the equipment
 - Gates will be closed after signs are in place. There will still be a drop-off area for residents to access 24hrs.
- Work on Huston Hill, Stein Ln, 3 Runs Rd, Barr Ln, near Lumber Twp line
- Mower and rake working well. Waiting on parts for the roller
- We got remaining chips from where roads were tar and chipped to use for winter.
- Have been working with Benezette. They owe 9 loads of millings

- Pipes sinking – cemented by Mack and Kevin. Needs to be replaced Strayer’s place. A lot of pipes need to be replaced.
- Jerry Run project was finished. Money left over in that account is for Nanny Run (2023 project)
