### **ROADMASTER REPORT**

  - So far have spent \$24,596.67 - \$13,500 millings, \$3,510 pipes, \$3,038.67 #4 and 2A stone, \$4,548 labor
  - Probably start back up after 4<sup>th</sup> of July
- Voted on looking for Backhoe – agreement with Best Line to rent for a month - if we want to keep will deduct rental from price.
  - 2011 with 4,700 miles ~\$31,000
