- Vote to amend purchases flail mower and limb saw – prices increased due to tariffs. Flail now \$4,200, Limb saw now \$3000
 - Jeff makes a motion to approve purchasing at new price, seconded by Dave.
- State passed new ATV law for roads where speed limit is <45 to use 555. We need to open Castle Garden Rd and 555. Working to get Grant to Huston is open. Accidents? None since the ATV ordinance adopted.
 - Jeff makes motion to open Castle Garden and both ways on 555, seconded by Scott.
- Mowing Roads – got some complaints, should hopefully be done by the end of week.
- Vote to split Fire Dept insurance with other municipalities. Will be around \$2,500 each.
 - Jeff makes a motion to pay, seconded by Dave.
